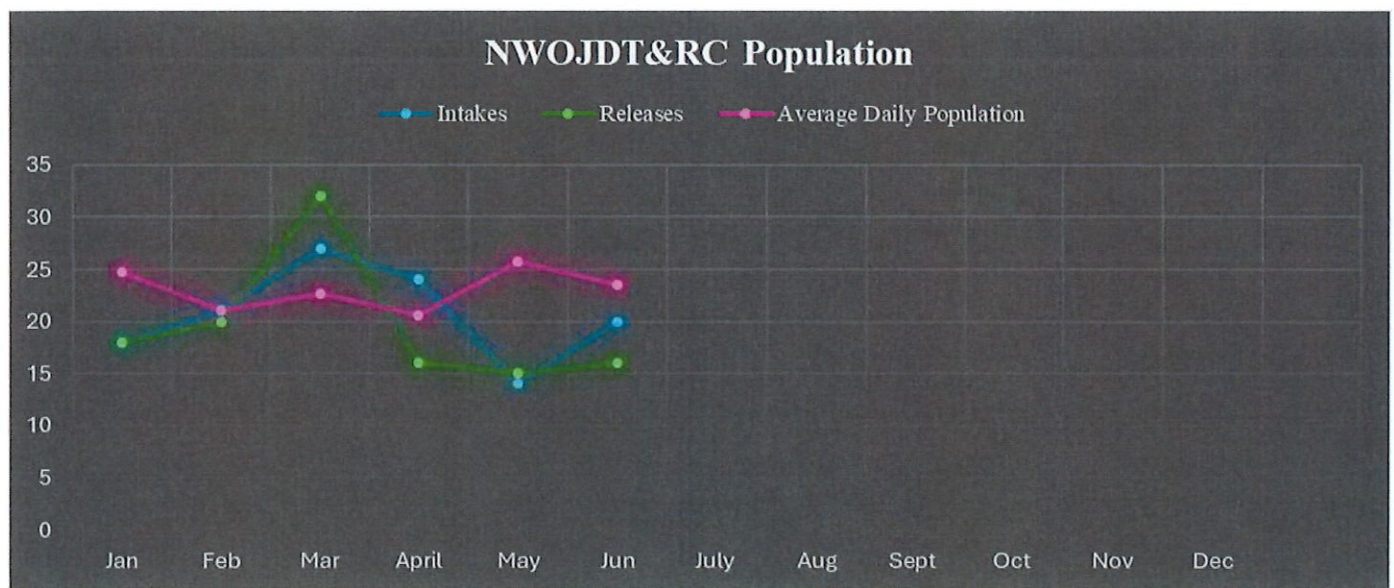

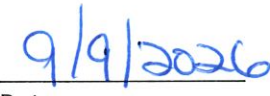
Joe Short complimented how nice the facility is looking and thanked Jones, Grime and Kessler for their hard work.

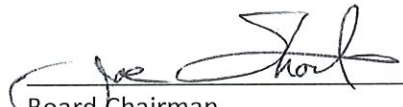
Joe Short motioned to adjourn. Michael Polley seconded. Discussion: None. Vote on motion: All Ayes, No Nays. Motion Carried.

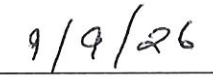
